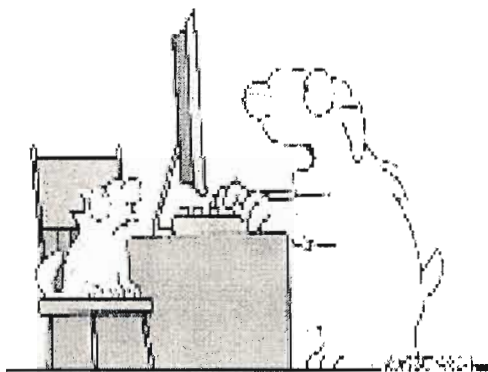

Speaking through an interpreter, Emine Yuzay described her life in the Turkish slums. Born without an arm, she was raised in poverty and was not able to attend school. As an older teenager, she was intrigued by a program near her neighborhood that was reaching out to poverty-stricken women for the purposes of teaching them to read. Emine resolved to participate. The program turned out to be a "concentrated language encounter" sponsored by Rotary International. Learning quickly, Emine was able to become an instructor in a very short time, paying forward to others what Rotary had given to her. She could hardly believe the path she has taken from the poor neighborhood in Turkey to addressing thousands of Rotarians in Salt Lake City. Our club can be proud of our literacy work in our own community, from our weekly donation of books to public school libraries to our contributions to Reading is Fundamental to various members volunteering many hours to our school system. In the spirit of the Rotary Foundation, we are doing good in the world.

LAST WEEK'S MEETING

Last week, we were greeted with a little, taped addition to our bulletin, a scandalous article written about **Bill Fahey**, thankfully redacted as to some of the more vulgar portions (all in good fun). **Barry Gainer** led a unique invocation, asking for member participation; sharing things to be thankful for. **Kent Weisner** was thankful for his expected 6th grandchild. **Chris Sorensen** was thankful that he wasn't the grumpiest one in attendance, that prize having been taken by **Frank Cashin**. **Chuck Lorenz** was thankful for a successful surgery involving a relative. **Charles English** was thankful for 26 years of marriage and **Barry** ended by expressing thanks in being a Rotarian. Bill Fahey welcomed our guests, including Charles English's wife, Patry. **Carol** had planned to ask Charles to introduce the speaker, Dr. Amiri, however, Charles ended up being the speaker. Dr. Amiri was in the hospital and Charles happily filled in. He spoke to us about meeting Dr. Amiri on a flight to Washington D.C. following 9/11 and learned about his Institute for the Study of Digital Inclusion. The Institute's purpose is to provide under-privileged children or adults with the same access to information technology at home and at school as other, more typical folks. Already, the Institute has given away more than 1,000 computers, promoting digital literacy. The program has a "Make-It, Take-It" aspect that allows students to physically take apart and reassemble a computer. Following this session, the students get to take home a newly refurbished computer of their own. The attendees are also taught basic computer software skills on PowerPoint, Excel, and Word thanks to a license granted by Microsoft. Another struggle for the Institute is obtaining high-speed internet access for the program's participants. A recent study at an Orange County school revealed that approximately 1/3 of the students did not have high-speed access at home. In Broward County, ATT has agreed to provide free internet access to kids in the program and four grants have been received in Orange County for this purpose. Another aspect of the Institute's work is that it provides an environmentally friendly way to dispose of used computers. **Pete Burg** asked about donating computers, however, Charles explained that getting computers really isn't the problem, it's the internet access that's hard to come by (i.e. donations are the most needed item). However they do take donations of computers capable of running Microsoft Office Professional. **Barry** explained that Seminole County has a similar program in our schools. Internet access is again the issue but contributions are being solicited, including one from Bright House for \$250,000! **Craig Corbett** suggested potential participation Institute with Public Libraries. **Bill Potter** mentioned Winter Springs' plan to provide WiFi access to all its residents, with **Dede** adding that it's also being considered throughout Seminole County. **Pete Osborn** gave ("Last Week".cont. on pg. 4)
