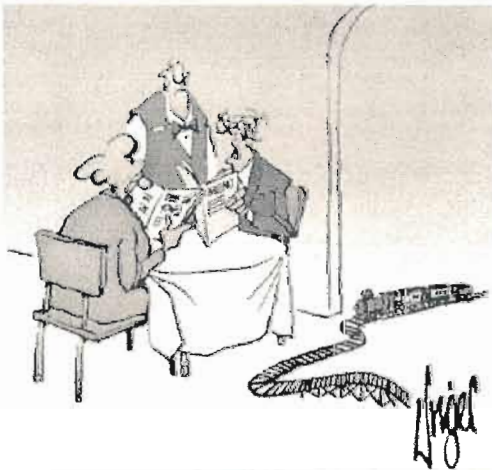

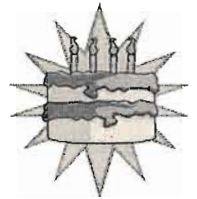

LAST WEEK'S MEETING

Last week was a busy meeting. Our speaker was Mr. Pete Schwob, a double lung recipient. Naturally, he spoke about organ donation. We learned that **Jerry Barrett's** wife donated a kidney some time back, interesting in that kidneys are the #1 donated organ. There are 97,000 Americans on an organ donor list, with 70% waiting for a kidney. There are many more on tissue waiting lists. One donor can potentially help 50 people in need, with 8 lives saved. You can become an organ donor by placing the identifier on your driver license or by filling out the appropriate paperwork. Pete also discussed some of the factors determining who folks are ranked on the waiting lists. Factors such as urgency, antibody capability, blood type, geographical considerations, organ size and religious beliefs are all pivotal determinations. Of special note are infants who can sometimes be transplanted with non-matching blood type organs without rejection. Pete also emphasized that doctors do not know whether you are an organ donor so they will do everything to save your life. There is no cost associated with becoming an organ donor, however it does cost \$2,700.00 to donate your body to science. Your age or sickness is not an issue. For more information on organ donations, Pete recommended "www.unos.com", "www.donatelife.net" and "www.fcod.org". **Bill Fahey** asked about families' opinions regarding the matter and **Al Assar** asked about a brain transplant (currently unavailable). **Ed Knight** spoke about how easy it is to become a donor and **Pete** asked about the impact of state laws on organ donation. Apparently, several states are considering presumptive donations. **Fred Poole** asked about the likelihood of needing a donated organ and **Dale** asked an excellent question on survival rates. Being as our speaker was a lung recipient, he confirmed that 50% of lung recipients live for at least 5 more years. Lungs are the most difficult trans-

Rotary Foundation "Thought of the Week" - Ambassadorial Scholarships

The Rotary Foundation began in 1917, but didn't become a major component of Rotary until founder Paul Harris's death in 1947. Upon Paul's death, more than \$1 million was contributed in memorial gifts. Shortly thereafter, the first program of the Foundation was established: Fellowship for Advanced Study - the forerunner to the now-popular Ambassadorial Scholarships program. The Rotary Foundation's Ambassadorial Scholarship program is one of the world's largest privately funded international scholarship programs for university studies. Since 1947, approximately 37,000 students from 110 countries have studied abroad, including Roger Ebert, Bill Moyers and Sadako Ogata, the former UN High Commissioner on Refugees.

plants with respect to infection, given their constant exposure to the air. The longest living lung recipient survived 28-29 years. **Carole Hinshaw** asked about any special precautions following transplants.
