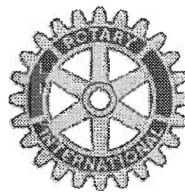
TODAY'S MESSAGE

Hurricanes Pummel Haiti

Four hurricanes within a span of a month have caused massive flooding in Haiti, sending local Rotarians scrambling to provide help for thousands displaced by the storms. Past RI Director Barry Rassin, of Nassau, Bahamas, says the onslaught of hurricanes Fay, Gustav, Hanna, and Ike has left many parts of the island inaccessible, including the port city of Gonaives. The United Nations has estimated that as many as 600,000 people are in need of help because of the storms, which have killed more than 200 people. “It’s just been so devastating,” Rassin says. “We have to wait for the flooding to go down to even be able to access some of the places.” Dick McCombe, 2007-08 governor of RI District 7020, and Rassin have been coordinating much of the Rotarian relief effort through the Haiti Task Force, set up a year ago to administer all Rotarian financial aid to Haiti. They are asking Rotarians to help out by sending donations. Information on how to do so is available at the RI Zones 33 and 34 Web site. Cash is being wire-transferred to Rotary contacts in the country, splitting it between regions. When containers of food come in, they are gone in a flash. The need is very great.


